Between 1993 and 1999, he progressed through various program and P&L IT leadership roles for GE Plastics in Asia and the US, before being appointed Chief Information Officer for GE Plastics Americas in 2000. Kevin was focused on digitalization of business processes and eCommerce development as well as enabling business productivity and growth through various IT initiatives. In 2002, Kevin joined GE Capital in the UK as Chief Information Officer for the Equipment Management businesses in Europe. Integration and rationalization of IT platforms was his key focus in this role. Between 2004 and 2011, he took on progressively larger IT leadership roles for GE Capital's Commercial Finance businesses in Europe, focusing on M&A, successfully integrating several commercial banking acquisitions. Subsequently, Kevin assumed the overall IT leadership role for all of GE Capital's International businesses, across all product lines and advanced a "digital first" IT strategy to drive business growth. From 2015, Kevin led the IT program to support the divestiture of GE Capital's international businesses which represented over \$100B in assets.

Kevin has regulatory experience and has held a board position for an IT shared services company within GE Capital.
